The scholarship will be awarded based on veteran status (including family members), financial need, scholastic ability, realistic goals, extra-curricular activities and community involvement. All students must show proof that they have been accepted at an accredited college or university prior to receiving the scholarship.

**All applications MUST be submitted to the Erie County American Legion Headquarters located at 609 City Hall, Buffalo, New York 14202, by Friday May 6, 2022 by Noon, or postmarked by that date.**

The Scholarships will be awarded at a site to be determined based on the awardees home area or at the 8<sup>th</sup> District Convention in North Tonawanda, NY 6/18/2022.
