2025 MEMBERSHIP DUES PAYMENT

This year as you transmit your per capita tax it will be for \$39.50 whether you pay it via MyLegion software to National, or by paper to Department. The \$39.50 includes this year's \$5 National increase. Erie County Finance Officer Joe Porempski will be sending out letters to all Posts indicating the Erie County per capita process of \$2 per member soon. Each Erie County Post will make a payment of \$2 per member based on their final 2024 membership directly to the Erie County Committee. This process mirrors the long-standing 8th District payment process, where the WNY Counties pay \$0.29 of their collected per capita each year based on the previous year's membership. This process means no additional payments will need to be made for PUFL or new members throughout the year. Please contact the Office if you have any questions.
